



Learn To Sew Camp - during this week of camp you will learn the parts of the machine, how to pin and cut, and how to straight stitch and zigzag. Your first project is a sewing bag which you will keep your sewing projects in. You can also make a pair of shorts, a top, or pick a craft to make.

**Once you have completed this week you may advance to as many other camps as you would like.*



Clothing Camp - during this week of camp you will make as many clothing items as time allows. You can make anything from shorts, a top, nightshirt, skirt, and much more.



Cloth Paper Doll Camp - during this week of camp you will make your own cloth paper doll and design and construct her wardrobe.



Quilt Camp - during this week of camp you will choose from precut quilt quilts and sew the pieces together. Then you will complete your quilt by sewing lines of quilting to secure the three layers together.



Craft Camp - during this week of camp you will make as many fabric crafts as time permits. Crafts include: pillows, windsocks, bean bag critters, bears, and much more!

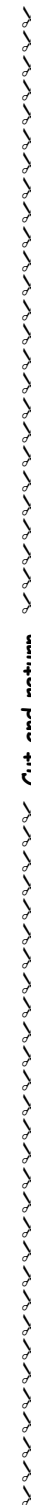

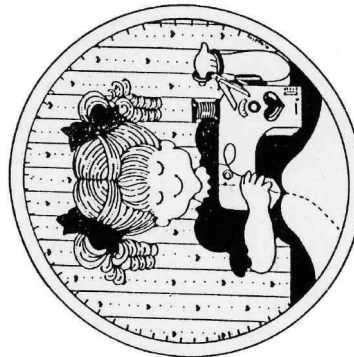
